

GETTING YOUR CLASS READY FOR BOOKS ON BREAK

What to expect:

Books on Break is a book fair without the cash registers. Your class will visit the fair at a designated time, and each student will be able to pick out 4-5 books to read over the summer and keep forever. Volunteers will be on site to help students pick out their books and bag them up.

A few tips:

- It's important for teachers to come with their class. While there will be volunteers to help the students, you know your students best and can help them pick out the most appropriate books.
- Now is a good time to revisit beginning of the year lessons on how to choose a just-right book. We don't want students to pick books that are too challenging and that they won't enjoy.
- Ask a classmate to help choose books for absent students.
- You are welcome to visit the media center during set-up to look at the book selection and help build excitement!
